idAnnotate = itool_obj -> FindIdentifiers('*/*ANNOTATION LAYER')  
oAnnotate = itool_obj -> getByIdentifier(idAnnotate)  
oAnnotate -> add, OBJ_NEW('IDLitVisText', _STRING = gtitle, $  
    ALIGNMENT      = 0.5, $  
    VERTICAL_ALIGNMENT = 1.0, $  
    FONT_SIZE      = 24, $  
    LOCATION        = [0.0, 0.70, 0.99])
```
