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- > Forget the environment, not portable anyway. Write your info into a
- > simple text file, and read that. On Unix a .myapprc file in the users
- > home will do, for Windows you have to do something else. Leave the
- > environment to the user, do not mess with it.

You can use that approach on Windows, too. You have to test if you're running on Windows, though. To get the user's home directory, you can getenv('USERPROFILE') and use that instead of ~.
