- > the colors we want. Get the current decomposed state (GET\_DECOMPOSED)
- > when you get the colors, and restore it when you restore the colors. :-)

Done. This has been good for my continuing growth in the area of IDL colors. Instead of setting decomposed, I replaced all the color specifications with calls to fsc\_color and color24 (with arguments come from widget\_system\_colors). I've also pixmap buffered the whole thing.
