> are, and I find that unicode 22A5 is for a box! The perpendicular
> line is listed as unicode 007C.

At risk of being unduly argumentative, I don't think 22A5 is supposed to be a box. I got that code from here:

<http://www.unicode.org/charts/PDF/U2200.pdf> You'll see which perpendicular symbol I'm trying to achieve there. Also, if you use, for example, 22A6 you also get a box when using the XP device fonts.

Thus, I stick by my assertion that many of the XP device fonts don't have the full unicode implementation and thus are less useful for specific tasks. Fortunately, as I noted I was able to get something satisfactory with vector fonts.
