Your limit of 19 simultaneously open files is NOT an MS Windows limit. In fact, when I have been running IDL under other OS's, I have run up against a 13 file limit. I suggest you look carefully at your code to see how to restructure it so you use fewer files. Make sure if you open files inside a for loop, you also close them inside the loop, etc.
