Dave writes:

> I've just received some feedback from a journal that the figures I
> created with iTools has lines that are simply too thick for
> publication. I saved the figure as a vector-based .eps file so this
> isn't a low-res bitmap.

Actually, what iTools prefer to save is NOT a "low-res" bitmap, but a very "high-res" bitmap. I wouldn't be surprised to find it is exactly what you had in mind. Have you tried it? It will be big, but it will probably be more accurate than the "low-res" vector output. :-)
