## **David Groff writes:**

- > Is there a way in IDL to check for problems when reading a data file?
- > For example in Fortran you would do something like
- > Error Status = Read (filename)
- > IF ( Error\_Status /= Success ) THEN
- -----(etc.)

- If something is wrong with the data file the problem would be discovered
- > via error\_status.

Typically, one uses a CATCH error handler for this, although ON IOERROR is still sometimes used. Here is a fairly old article that explains some of the details:
