Having just installed IDL 6.3 on a new MacBook Pro running OS X 10.4.8, and having just updated X11, I find that CURSOR refuses to respond to mouse events. Yes, I have tried using keywords instead of the wait parameter. Cursor,x,y,/down (or any other flag) hangs the window, and the only way to get out is to kill the window directly. The only way that I can get any information back at all is if I use cursor,x,y,/nowait.
