Let me second this recommendation. I make extensive use of these routines and they're quite good. It's very easy to get data into or out of mysql.

The only hiccup is that if you try a malformed SQL query or otherwise confuse mysql, the IDL/MySQL link becomes unresponsive. For personal use it's easy enough just to reset and open up a new session, but you might want to be careful about using this code in a production environment - or at least, be sure to check all your SQL carefully!
