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Is it possible to determine where one is on a gif image after one draws a character string automatically? That is, w/o interactively using the CURSOR command? What I am doing is writing a character string on a gif file in helvetica font. I'd like to return what pixels on the gif are covered by a rectangle surrounding the character string. Unfortunately, it doesn't appear that letters in helvetica are the same width so I can't simply calculate the pixel length based on the length of the character string.

Another possibility might be to calculate somehow how long a string is in a certain font but I don't know how to do that either.

Any pointers would be appreciated.

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
