I've never really liked the MPEG routines in IDL for a variety of reasons (everything from quality of output to inconsistencies in the movie headers that can cause them to play incorrectly when launched from PowerPoint). Macs are supposed to be god's gift to movies, so I am certain that there are 10^4 ways of making a movie out of a few hundred TIFF files, but I'd settle for one that will make a high quality output with a sensible codec and variable frame rate.
