PolyFillV is not using the provided polygons coordinates but a "fix()" of them.... which induce this extra line on the left and at the bottom (and a few missing pixels on the right side and on the top If I remember well). I personnaly used a round() over my polygon coordinates and it was returning much better results... though still not perfect!
