I have a very larger byte array. Whenever I try to do anything with it or create a new variable I get the ever present temporary resources unavailable.

Could someone offer some workarounds. Here's what I do.

I read a file into a 4D array of a size like 93x181x42x31. I then want to shift one of the bins like, i.e.,

```
openr,1,file
readu,1,a
close,1
vol = byte(a, 12, 93, 181, 42, 31)
vol = shift(vol, 0, 0, 21, 0)
^^^^
```

It's after this that I get the error. I have tried to do the following: vol = shift(temporary(vol),0,0,21,0)

Now, not only do I get the error, but I lost the whole var as well.

Any suggestions accepted.
