JD Smith wrote:

- > That's a first (no Intel Mac here). Do you happen to have more than
- > one IDL 6.3 version installed? My guess is that from the terminal you
- > are running one version, and from IDLWAVE another, likely do to
- > differences in the environment (e.g. search path) between them.

Okay, I have 6.3 and 6.1 installed, and I've found the problem and a (messy) solution.

IDLWAVE appears to call IDL from the idl_6.1 folder, rather than from \$IDL_DIR or ...rsi/idl, both of which point to idl_6.3. This means that idl_6.1/bin/idl is executed, which assumes that if OS="darwin" then ARCH=".ppc". It then calls \$IDL_DIR/bin/bin.\$OS\$ARCH, i.e., 6.3 PPC version.

My messy solution is to move the 6.1 folder and create a link idl_6.1 -> ... idl_6.3. So when IDLWAVE attempts to call idl_6.1 it actually calls idl_6.3.

Any idea why IDLWAVE should call idl_6.1 rather than the default?
