- > in ASCII format into a stereographic (or other) projection.
- > It should also be possible to draw a grid and/or a landmask.

- > for my problem.
- > Can someone help me?

I have not tried this myself, but I would expect that CONVERT_COORD could be used to convert from data (lon,lat) coords to either device of normal coordinates and then a simple XYOUTS could be used to place the label.

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
