What do you mean by "subset [an] image with [a] smaller image"? I know what subsetting means, and the result creates a smaller image, but I don't understand where the word "with" comes in.

REBIN is usable for subsetting if you're subsetting by an integral factor on each dimension. CONGRID is the routine you need if it isn't an integral factor.

I don't know of any special problems with doing this in batch mode.
What have you attempted, and how does it fail?
