- > WIDGET_CONTROL, /RESET. But then when I start up the widget again it
- > is unresponsive; the buttons and menus can be manipulated but they
- > don't call the event handler. Right now the only way I know of to
- > restart the widget is to exit and restart IDL.

Take a look at your terminal window when it is unresponsive, you will probably see the IDL prompt. If so then just type XMANAGER to start the event processing.

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
