The easiest way to get around this is to put functions that are referenced by other functions earlier in the source code, before the functions that reference them. In this way, they are compiled first.

If you are going to use the forward_function statement, I think you have to give it global scope (don't put it within the context of a function). Just an idea, I've never used this statement. I've just always made sure functions which are called later on in the source file appear first.
