I considered the 32/64 bit possibility, but I think they're all 64 biters. I'm not sure the exact incantation to find out, but it looks like the `idl_assistant` script calls

```
/bin/isainfo -b
```

Which gives an answer of 64 on all of the machines. It looks like they all claim they can run both 32 and 64 bit applications based on

```
/bin/isainfo -v
```

I'm afraid it might be this NFS file locking issue mentioned by Nigel Wade.
