I often spawn the unix wc (word count) program to asses the length of an ascii file. In fact I (and probably others as well) have written a simple routine which employs "getwrd.pro" from the JHUALP library:

function n_lines,file
```

```
;this will tell you how many lines a text file is
```

```
; Usage: N = n_lines("myfile.dat")
```

```
spawn,'wc '+ file, output      ;unix word count command
```

```
return,getwrd(output(0),0)
```

```
end
```
