> Are the relative sizes of these two windows configurable?

The defaults can be configured with idlwave-shell-frame-parameters, assuming you are using a separate "frame" (Emacs for window) for the shell. It's configurable in general shell setup. It should be 30 lines tall by default. The original source buffer should not change size. If it does, it's probably some misfeature of the window manager or OS.
