> majority of the window? Perhaps I'm thick, but this has been bugging me  
> for a while, and I can't figure out how to do it.

Yes, I would appreciate an easy way to do this too, like an XMARGIN and YMARGIN keywords that work like the PLOT commands'. Currently, I get the visualization layer and set the VIEWPLANE\_RECT property to get the margins I want.

There is a FIT\_TO\_VIEW keyword in IDL 6.4 which will make the visualization to take up the \*entire\* view.
