```
array = ['one', 'two', 'three']
print, array
n = N_ELEMENTS(array)
print, n
FOR i=0,n-1 DO BEGIN
    PRINT, array[i]
ENDFOR
```

However, I got error message as follows:

```
IDL> @test
one two three
