> As word to the wise, our entire department is unable to run tv
> commands with idl 6.2 without having it "segmentation fault" and
> die. Our department runs Fedora Core 5, and idl 6.2, and in the past
> 24 hours there have been the following updates:
> Apr 12 04:43:48 Updated: xorg-x11-server-Xorg.x86_64 1.0.1-9.fc5.7
> Apr 12 04:44:18 Updated: libX11.i386 1.0.0-4.fc5
> Apr 12 04:44:19 Updated: libX11.x86_64 1.0.0-4.fc5
> Apr 12 04:44:25 Updated: libX11-devel.x86_64 1.0.0-4.fc5
>
> Since I'm sure that if I report this to RSI I'll get told its a linux
> problem, and if I report this to Fedora I'll be told its an
> application problem, I'll just wait and see how long until this gets
> fixed. But I thought I might want to pass the word on to others in
> case someone is busy trying to debug why their IDL sessions are dying.

I've had e-mails to this effect today, too. Something
bad is happening in those updates!
