I guess I would argue that what is being displayed is EXACTLY
what is being stored:

```
IDL> print, 470, format='(f18.14)'
470.0000000000000000
IDL> print, 4.70*100, format='(f18.14)'
469.99996948242187
IDL> print, 470.0000000000000000D - 469.99996948242187D, format='(f18.14)'
0.00003051757813
```
