> I would guess it depends entirely on how big you want
> the PostScript image to be. Why don't you try it and
> see? It is only a couple of commands:
>
> Read_JPEG, filename, image
> Set_Plot, 'PS'
> Device, /color, bits=8, /encap, xsize=5, ysize=3.5, /inches
> TVImge, image
> Device, /Close
```

Well, lots of good non-IDL solutions. But in my little test, using the rose.jpg file from the IDL distribution. I got a file that weighed in at a hefty 204 KBytes. :-)
