> % Subscript range values of the form low:high must be >= 0, < size,
> with low <= high: X.

> LARMOR/dipole/animate.pro
> % \$MAIN\$

You might try to use a long variable as counter:

FOR j=1l,9999l do begin ...

Just a random guess, though.
