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IDL doesn't really support international (Unicode) characters which is the cause of this issue. When a recordset object connects to a table, it defines an anonymous structure that maps to a table record. When it does this, it uses the field names to build structure tags. This is what's causing the above error.

Really no work around except to build a new table that uses roman (English) characters.
