- > I have a procedure that I have modified from an older version that IDL
- > cannot seem to find. My old routine was called
- > 'gen wkly snr dates.pro' and the new one is called
- > 'gen wkly snr dates v2.pro'. I moved the old procedure out of any of
- > the folders in the path to test the new one. This is what happens
- > when I attempt to compile it:

- > IDL> .compile gen_wkly_snr_dates_v2
- > % Compiled module: GEN_WKLY_SNR_DATES.
- > IDL> gen_wkly_snr_dates_v2
- > % Compiled module: GEN WKLY SNR DATES V2.
- > % Attempt to call undefined procedure/function:
- > 'GEN WKLY SNR DATES V2'.
- > % Execution halted at: \$MAIN\$

- > It compiles the old routine when I want it to compile the new one.
- > The new one is in the current working directory. I've tried exiting
- > IDL and restarting but I get the same message. What is wrong?

Make sure the name of the procedure is EXACTLY the same as the name of the file, or you will be wasting all your time compiling files that don't need to be compiled. :-)
