You'll need to use the "AS" clause in your SELECT to rename your columns. Something like:

```
CREATE OR REPLACE VIEW myIDLDataminerTable AS
SELECT
    columnOne AS colOne,
    funkyName AS notFunkyName,
    columnThree AS colThree
FROM myFunkyTable;
```

You will need privileges on the database to create a view so you may have to ask your DBA to do this. Once created, anyone with select privileges will be able to query it.
