Hi Rick,  
Have you thought about using netcat? You could SPAWN a pipe to communicate with your equipment. This would get the commands to it, but with UDP, you will probably need a separately SPAWN'ed nc process with -l -u options to receive responses. Try something like  
SPAWN,'nc -u <host> <port>',UNIT=unit  
Then use WRITEU to send your commands, see online help. Don't forget to CLOSE and FREE\_LUN your unit.  
Maybe you can play a bit with nc on the unix command line to see if you can make it talk to your equipment.
