If I'm understanding you correctly,

```
iplot, x, y, xrange=[-6.5, 7.5]
```

will do the second part (putting the values "a bit inside"). I think the XTICKVALUES keyword should have solved the first part (maybe with adding the XMAJOR keyword), but I couldn't get the result I was expecting from:

```
iplot, x, y, xtickvalues=x, xmajor=5, xrange=[-6.5, 7.5]
```

(as a matter of fact, XTICKVALUES didn't seem to ever have any effect).
