## Huh? Say what!?

Put your structure definition in the LAST module in the file. Name the module STRUCT\_\_DEFINE and name the file struct\_\_define.pro and you are finished. (Two underscores in both the module and filenames.) Then just make the object:

IDL> obj = Obj\_New('Struct')
