One can compile in IDL and typos are caught at that stage, like in a true compiled language. That would be the solution for the original poster. To illustrate:

% Compiled module: \$MAIN\$. % Variable is undefined: C.

% Execution halted at: \$MAIN\$ 1 test.pro
