I'm not sure "no good" is how I would describe it. I think "exactly what you want and expect" is probably a better description. Normalized coordinates are referenced to the \*display window\* and \*never\* to a plot.

If you wanted to use normalized coordinates, then you should get your bearings from the ![XY]. Window system variables after each plot.
