May be this is already been discussed or trivial. In any case, I have multiple plots that go into same page, and I would like to position text within each of these sub windows, as they are plotted from within a loop, while using !p.multi.

What is the best way to do it? For example, I have !

p.multi=[0,2,7,0,1]. Say, I would like to put the station codes inside each of these 14 subwindows. I tried 'xyouts' with a bunch of combinations, but didn't work. I was thinking that when we use default data coordinates, then if we specify the location of each call to xyouts based on "data" specific to that window, then it should put the text at the correct location within that specific window. But it's not?! :-(Appreciate any help.
