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Dear All,

I'm trying to create a format string that looks like this: (5(""
A0, "", :, ", ")) <- There are single quotation marks between the
first two double quotations.

I want to get something like this

```
a = SINDGEN(6)
print, a, FORMAT=val_fmt
```

to get:

```
'0', '1', '2', '3', '4', '5'
```

What i currently have for a format string is this:

```
val_fmt = '( ' + STRTRIM(STRING(cnt), 2) + $
'(' + "" + ', A0, ' + "" + ', :, ", ") )'
```

This one is wrong because it does not contain the double quotation
marks enclosing the single quotation marks. Can someone please
explain to me how I could do it or tips on how to use the BYTE method
to produce a string output like this.
