> widget\_control, b,/realize  
>  
> Would string([13b,10b]) work under Windows? If not, any other  
> recommendation for a multi-line label?

It unattractive, but supplying YSIZE to widget\_label() works in

windows. The trouble is the UNITS

keyword doesn't offer lines as an option, just pixels, centimeters,  
and inches.
