Hi Folks,

Does anyone know of a handy way of parsing URLs in IDL? Or even a nice perl script to do it? The situation is that we have a server that can accept SQL queries via URL encoding of a get command, which works in the main part but falls over with '&' and '+' type syntax.

I'll write a regexp version myself if necessary, but it's not trivial - you have to ensure the ordering is correct as there are several encodings which use characters which would otherwise be replaced.
