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How do I truncate a multidimensional array at a different place for each dimension i.e. I start with 3x6 array of values A=

```
0 0 0
0 0 0
0 0 0
0 0 0
0 0 0
0 0 0
```

and want to truncate each dimension at a fixed value stored in an array B, where the values are (2,3,4) for example so that I get:

```
0 0 0
0 0 0
0 0 0
  0 0
    0
```

Is that possible? Or does my array have to be square so have to truncate the whole thing at element 4 for example?
