I'm plotting a box of values (representing dielectrics) with SHADE\_SURF and rotating it so that the view is directly overhead. I'm using a 16-level color pallete so that the differences in the values are distinct. I'd like to be able to print small numbers over the graph corresponding to the value at particular points. The graph would then display regions with similar value with that value printed on top of the graph. When I say "over" and "on top of", I mean that the numbers would be printed at the same place as the regions (not at the top of the window). I'm not sure if this is possible. Can someone help me?
