Hi,

I've been experimenting with locking sav files.

- * A process should not interrupt another processes attempt to modify a sav file.
- * Each process deals with copies of their sav files until they call "commit"
- * If a process if blocked from committing its sav files then it should enter a queue (FIFO)
- * A process will wait on the queue until it can commit or there is a timeout
- * There is a maximum number of active processes (default: 8) and size of the commit queue (default: 4)
- * The system must work equally well regardless of backing store (NTFS,FAT32,Samba,NFS)
