The first image was done successfully, but I got this error message when the loop was going to next image...

"Openw: Error opening file. unit 100. file: D:\MODIS07\processed\D:\MODIS07\processed\solza_swath_2D_1.img"

Actually, 'D:\MODIS07\processed' is the folder that output image files will be stored. I don't know why this pathname was written twice.

When I process many *.hdf files at once, I make a batch file and write the names of *.hdf files on it, and then process. Maybe there is some kind of confliction between my way and MCTK way. I would like to try MCTK way this time.

How do you usually do when you need to process many files at once? for example,
