Or update to IDL 6.4 (in which case you may get to consult a different techtip for yet another workaround -- 4228)

Some of the information techtip 4177 is no longer useful. For Fedora Core 6 it recommends installing an older version of libX11, but this is no longer available in repositories. One option is to recompile the library, after editing the SPEC file to omit the patch.
