I have found a workaround, which does not require deprecating the system X11 library.

- 1. find a copy of the old "working" libX11.so.6 file and copy it somewhere, eg. /my/private/lib/libX11.so.6
- 2. bash: export LD\_PRELOAD\_PATH=/my/private/lib tcsh: setenv LD\_PRELOAD\_PATH /my/private/lib
- 3. run IDL

Now IDL will use /my/private/lib/libX11.so.6 instead of the system library and it will work correctly.
