> However, write_png is working fine from the command line.
> So I wonder where it's supposed to be. I did notice that there's a
> /Applications/rsi/idl_6.3/bin/bin.darwin.ppc/idl_png.dlm and a
> similar .so
> Maybe they get their functionality from another means.

Aha, there it is :) The wrapper (write_image) communicates with the png library, which's been packaged into a dlm, so they can be accessed from within IDL, like native commands. I suspected this might be the case, but actually looked only inside the /lib.
