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Hi all,

I've used the INT_TABULATED math library function successfully before,
but now it's giving me problems. For example:

```
IDL> x = findgen(101)
IDL> y = x^2
IDL> print,int_tabulated(x,y)

      z = spl_interp(x, f, spl_init(x, f, /double), xgrid, /double)
              ^
```
