Try this:

```
s = [10.3, 9.6, 9.2, 8.5, 7.7, 6.9, 5.8, 5.4, 4.7, 4.1]  
l = Findgen(100) * 0.5  
P.MULTI=[0,1,2]  
Window  
Plot, Congrid(s, N_Elements(l))  
Plot, Congrid(s, N_Elements(l), /INTERP)  
!P.MULTI=0
```
