> PLOT, CONGRID(smallarray, N_ELEMENTS(largearray), 1, 1) <- With our
> without the INTERP keyword

The INTERP keyword will be set like this:

```
Plot, Congrid(sm, N_Elements(large), /INTERP)
```

Or, like this:

```
Plot, Congrid(sm, N_Elements(large), INTERP=1)
```
