> Is restore not a command that is able to be shared?

RESTORE is certainly a command that can be used. Probably your program is not finding the file where it expects to find it (that is, in the same directory that the SAVE file is located). Remember that your start up file, etc. do NOT get run on the VM, so everything has to be located in the same place if you expect to find it. Of course, your program has to be written to look in that place, too. :-)
